While Grasshopper looks good, he is somewhat inexperienced, although at this time of the year, the fresher horses can do well. His trainer is a master as well, so he could do it. The rest don't offer any value to me. Presuming the weather is okay, and we don't have torrential rains, the bets won't change.
